

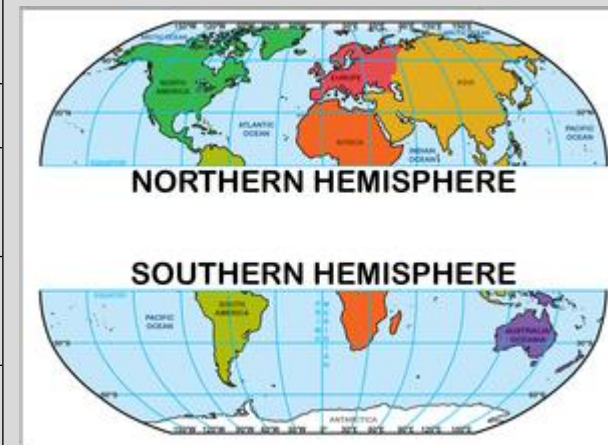
Subject Specific Vocabulary

continent	a massive area of land separated by water or other natural features

Northern Hemisphere	the section of the Earth that is North of the Equator
Southern Hemisphere	the section of the Earth that is South of the Equator
Equator	an imaginary line that splits the Earth into the Northern and Southern Hemisphere
climate	weather in a particular place since you have been born
direction	the path that something takes
key	to tell you what the symbols on a map mean
Ordnance Survey Map	a map showing the landscape's human and physical features
comparison	look at what is the same and different between two things or places
